Action: **Designed to turn/roll...LOCKABLE by User**

Benefits: Designed for persons who live independently, but experience difficulty “scotting” themselves up-to the table. Persons can confidently be seated knowing the brakes prevent the chair from rolling away. Once seated, the seated person releases the brakes, enabling them to propel themselves (sit-walking) up-to the table using both hands/feet for guidance.

Features: An armed chair (22” wide) to which the CADDIE is attached. The Brake-Release-Lever is positioned beside the seat of the chair...in easy reach of the seated person. The CADDIE includes 4 casters, 2 of which rotate 360°.
